LAND FOR ROAD SHED

The Clerk was instructed to write Cummings and ask if he would sell a certain piece of land in Blanding. Said land to be used for a yard to store County Road equipment.

WELFARE BOARD

It was moved by Sitton and seconded by Crowley that the Clerk be instructed to write a letter to the State Welfare Board protesting the action in not allowing a full time Director for San Juan County, and urge that one be reinstated as it was before San Juan was taken into the district. Carried unanimously. Clerk to send copy of the letter to the Governor.

SAN JUAN COUNTY FAIR BOARD

It was moved by Sitton and seconded by Crowley that the Clerk turn over to the San Juan County Fair Board the \$300.00 from the Exhibit Fund that had previously been set up for that purpose.

TYPE WRITER

A motion by Crowley and seconded by Rogers to authorize E. O. Biggs, County Agent to trade in the old typewriter being used in the Extension Service office on a new typewriter where he could trade to the best advantage was passed unanimously.

LAND SALE CONTRACT

On request of Donald T. Adams, it was moved by Rogers and seconded by Sitton that the contract made June 10, 1944 between San Juan County and F. W. Keller be reinstated and a deed issued upon payment in full. Said contract had been held up because of a blot on the title.

QUANSET BUILDING

J. W. Crowley moved that the County have erected a 40x60 foot Quonset Steel Building to store County road equipment, said building to be placed at the Fair Grounds. The motion was seconded by Rogers and carried unanimously.

SELECTIVE SERVICE OFFICE

Upon motion of Mr. Sitton and seconded by Mr. Rogers it was voted unanimously to let the Selective Service have the office space they are now occupying rent free beginning Sept. 1. Carried

The Board of County Commissioners met this day in regular meeting in Clerk's office. All members and Clerk present.

Miss Melva Decker, representing the Baptist Community Church, asked that the taxes on the property assessed to Tal. Mowash be cancelled as the property really belongs to the Utah Baptist Mission and is used as a parsonage. It was agreed that the tax should be cancelled as an erroneous assessment.

It was unanimously agreed that in as much as there is an immediate need of repair work on the Bluff River Flood Control Project, that an appeal to the Army Engineers for financial aid should be made. N. W. Sitton telephoned the Army Engineers and stated the case, but they informed him that they did not have any funds for such work. The Bluff residents who have met with the Commissioners were assured that if aid from the Government is not forthcoming that the County would start work with County equipment and do what is possible with the funds on hand. The Clerk was instructed to write Representative Granger and present the case to him.

The Clerk was instructed to buy two medical contracts from the San Juan County Medical Association for the use of County Indigents.

Ralph Bailey and Keith Redd, representing the Lion's Club, asked that the Commissioners join with them in petitioning the Utah State Fish and Game Commission for the immediate appointment of a Game Warden and enough deputies to take care of the deer during Hunting Season, according to a motion by Crowley and seconded by Sitton to cooperate with the Lion's Club in this move, and ask that all appointments and actions in the matter be made openly that prospective hunters may be more fully informed in the law. Carried unanimously.

A motion by Sitton and seconded by Rogers that the County take a one-fourth page in Desert News Christmas Edition was carried unanimously. Consideration \$160.
