Mr. Earl S. Stevens of the Fish and Wildlife Service informed the Commissioners that the Government required that a Government appointed man handle the Compound 10-80 used for Rodent Control.. and asked if the County would be willing to pay a man for two months for doing this work. It was moved by John D. Rogers and seconded by J. W. Crowley that the County pay a government trapper to do the Rodent work for the months of July and August at \$250.00 per month.

It was voted unanimously to appoint R. A. Holden as road supervisor at a salary of \$240.00 per month. David L. Guyman was made assistant Supervisor at \$225.00 per month.
