

PUBLIC NOTICE

I hereby inform you that candidates are to be elected for the following offices at the upcoming General Election in San Juan County, Utah, to be held **Tuesday, November 6, 2012**. The declaration of candidacy filing period for these offices begins on **Friday March 9 and ends at 5:00 PM Thursday, March 15, 2012**. Any Utah resident intending to become a candidate for any elective office to be filled at the next ensuing November General Election shall file with the County Clerk for all County and local Board of Education offices, solely within the county, or with the Lieutenant Governor for all other offices. The deadline for filing is March 15, 2012, 5:00 P.M.

FEDERAL

President and Vice-President for a four (4) year term.

U.S. Senate. One Senator for a six (6) year term.

U.S. House of Representatives. The Third Congressional District for a two (2) year term.

STATE

State Executive. Each of the following positions will be elected for a four (4) year term.

- (1). Governor
- (2). Lieutenant Governor
- (3). Attorney General
- (4). State Auditor
- (5). State Treasurer

State Senate - District 27 for a four (4) year term.

State House of Representatives - District 73 for a two (2) year term.

LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION - District 1, District 2 and District 3

Each position will be elected for a Four (4) year term.

JUDICIAL

Court of Appeals. There will be an unopposed retention election for one (1) Court of Appeals Judge provided that the incumbents whose term is expiring files during the filing period.

COUNTY

County Commissioner - District 1 for a Four (4) year term.

Candidates for all of the above offices will be voted on by all San Juan County, Utah, registered voters with these exceptions: 1) only registered voters in County Commission

District No. 1 will vote on candidates from that district; 2) only registered voters in Local Board of Education District 1 will vote on school board candidates from that school district; 3) only registered voters in Local Board of Education District 2 will vote on school board candidates from that school district; 4) only registered voters in Local Board of Education District 3 will vote on school board candidates from that school district.

Ballot Propositions – As of the date of this notice the County Clerk is not aware of any ballot propositions to be posted on the 2012 general election ballot.
